Mentor assignments are usually scheduled at the beginning or end of the school day; however, flexible schedules may be arranged by calling the respective School Site Mentor Liaison below.</p> <p>The mentor role promotes academic achievement and self-sufficiency skills for all students. Additionally, mentors should provide positive reinforcement and interaction with students. The Student Success Plan (SSP) is a support tool which acts as a guide for this process.</p>
