Considerations—

- Scarecrows must be free-standing or staked
- Use weatherproof materials only (this is an outdoor show).
- Expensive materials are discouraged; sponsors are not liable for theft or damage to scarecrows.
- Do not exceed 8-foot height limit.
- Individual or collaborative entries welcome.
- You may enter more than one scarecrow.

- > Bring your scarecrow to Scarecrow Park in Old Sacramento (120 J Street) October 6-7 between 3-6 p.m. Additional entry forms will be available on site. There is no cost to enter!
