

U.S. Constitution Examination Application

Certification, as authorized by Ed Code, Sec 44335 and 80415, will be granted when this test is passed with a score of 100 (80%) or higher. The test consists of two parts: Fifty multiple choice questions worth two points each and four 10 point essay questions relating to the U.S. Constitution and the responsibilities of citizenship. Passage of this test permits the candidate to apply for a full-time (five year) preliminary credential (or the four year extension). CTC accepts this certification for designated subjects credentials as well as single subject and multiple subject credentials. Test results will be recorded and placed on file in the Office of Continuing Education, San Jose State University. No Credit is granted.

The total test administration fee is \$55. The fee covers a test preparation guide (which will be mailed directly to you) and administration costs. Fees are non-refundable and are valid for 1 year. Fee payment requires you to write two separate checks as follows:

- \$20.00 payable to SCOE
