The Sacramento County Office of Education (SCOE) Administration has an interest in negotiating the following topics pertaining to the Sacramento County Office of Education Teacher Association (SCOETA) contract:

Article VIII: School and Contract Calendars

SCOE has an interest in assuring quality and continuity to programs for students in court and community schools and students in special education programs. This will necessitate that employee calendars be developed to assure consistent program services without interruption and reduce the need to employ substitute teachers.

Article XXXIV: Community Schools

SCOE has an interest in maximizing flexibility in serving students placed in community school settings and therefore is interested in discussing class size caps and the need for flexibility.
