We understand that the textbooks have been ordered as of August 20 and 27, 2008 and staff will be processing and checking the textbooks out to students soon after delivery. In the case of the sixth grade using Houghton Mifflin instead of Glencoe/McGraw Hill ELA, we understand that the request to approve Houghton Mifflin as the publisher for the district sixth grade ELA adoption is on the Board Agenda for September 16, 2008.

The *Education Code* provides school districts the opportunity to remedy deficiencies found during the Williams review. The county superintendent is responsible to ensure that any deficiency is remedied within the first eight weeks of the school term.² If, however, the plan to remedy the insufficiency is not implemented, the county superintendent is required to request that the Superintendent of Public Instruction purchase the needed textbooks for the school with the purchase treated as a loan to the district.

¹*Education Code* 1240(i) requires the county superintendent of schools to enforce the use of state textbooks regularly adopted by the proper authority and defines sufficient textbooks as each pupil, including English learners, has a textbook or instructional materials, or both, to use in class and to take home.

² *Education Code* Section 1240(i)(4)(C) requires remediation of a deficiency no later than the second month of the school term.
