Professional Learning Modules

Communities of Practice

SCOE 21CSLA Communities of Practice will meet in virtual, facilitated sessions in job-alike groups as well as school and district teams. Using continuous improvement principles, cohorts will interact regularly to focus on shared problems of practice to learn new and better ways to accomplish their professional and organizational goals. Separate Communities of Practice will be developed for each of the following groups:

- Mixed Groups



Individualized Leadership Coaching

Participants will receive 25 hours of job-embedded, goal-oriented, confidential, equity-focused leadership coaching throughout the year. Coaching sessions will be delivered through both virtual and in-person formats. Participants will be matched with a high-quality, experienced, and trained leadership coach; dates and times will be mutually determined by participant and coach.
