Participants are partnered with a high-quality, experienced, and trained coach who support education leaders through a collaborative trust-based, non-evaluative relationship; shared culture of inquiry and continuous improvement; identification and alignment of strengths, resources, and time; and focus on the self-identified needs and goals that support all students.

SCOE 21CSLA coaches help leaders to clarify, develop, and act on leadership development and equity goals by providing ongoing dialogue, feedback, and reflection. The coaching becomes a catalyst for developing a leader's capacity, skills, knowledge, behaviors, and confidence.

Teacher Leaders: Teacher leaders who support classroom teachers (instructional coaches, leadership team members, teachers on special assignment, department chairs, etc.)
