SUICIDE PREVENTION

ARR 5141.52

The Sacramento County Office of Education’s (SCOE) Prevention and Early Intervention Department shall serve as the suicide prevention point of contact for SCOE schools and programs (prevention@scoe.net). The Program will act as a resource in providing and reviewing suicide prevention training, resources, and referrals. In addition, each school site administrator (e.g., principal) shall serve as the liaison to SCOE’s suicide prevention point of contact, and coordinate and implement suicide prevention activities on their specific campus. The specific procedures for prevention, intervention, and response to suicide prevention can be found in SCOE’s Crisis Response Plan, which will be provided to every SCOE school site administrator.
