# Getting Started with DataQuest

Choose the highest level of data you want to see. For example, if you want to look at multiple schools in a district, select **District**.

Select one of the many **Subject** areas available. Explore test scores, school performance, demographics, staffing data, and more.

Most DataQuest reports require additional information, such as the year, school, or district you would like to include on your report. Once you enter that information, you will see a list of available reports. Select a report and click the **Submit** button to see your results.

## Will the results *really* answer your question?

You won't know whether the results answer your question until you do two things:

1. **Read the Report Description** for more information about the data. Some reports include a Report Glossary to define terms. The Report Description can include important information about where data came from and how it was compiled so that you can make sure it is really answering your question.

**Check the Report Options and Filters** to make sure the results represent the population you want to include. **⚠ Caution!** Filter settings can change depending on the level and report you choose. Your previous selections are not saved when you run a report, so review them each time you look at a report to make sure they are correct. **Report Filters can have a big impact on results.**

The **School Type** filter allows you to filter out charter schools, and many reports let you filter by various student characteristics, including program subgroups, so that you can compare results between different types of students.

## Important to know

- ★ When you change a report filter, DataQuest will automatically refresh the results. This can take a few seconds. Make sure the browser is finished loading the page before using the results.
- ★ For certain reports, like test scores, when the population of students is too small to ensure privacy, results are blocked. You will see an asterisk (\*) instead of a number.
- ★ DataQuest publishes data on a yearly calendar. Data availability is based on data submission deadlines schools and districts are required to meet.
- ★ You may see slight changes in numbers over time as data in CALPADS is corrected or when key report rules and definitions are changed.

# Getting Started with Ed-Data

Choose a county. If you want to drill down further, you can also choose a district and school.

Click the **Go** button to see the available reports.

## Will the results *really* answer your question?

Many reports include a drop-down menu at the top where you can apply filters to see a subset of the population or see the data broken into groups. Each report is displayed as a graph, but you can look at the raw data by clicking on **View Table Data**.

You won't know whether the results answer your question until you **Read the Chart Notes** for more information about the data. The Chart Notes can include important information about how the data was compiled so that you can make sure it is really answering your question. The **Source** tab tells you where the data came from.

Don't forget to check the **Glossary** for important definitions. You'll always find the glossary at the top right-hand corner of the page.

When the population of students is too small to ensure privacy, results are blocked. You will see **Redacted** instead of a number in tabular results, and portions of graphs will be blank.




