- Final validated redistricting data was released by the California Department of Finance on September 27.
- Notable changes in the area served by the Sacramento County Board of Education ("SCBOE") from 2010 to 2020, include:
 - Overall population growth of over 167,000 (11.9%);
 - Changes in the demographic composition, most notably, increases in the proportional share of Hispanic/Latino and Asian populations.
- These changes represent an 8.3% population variance among SCBOE trustee areas, which is within the 10% threshold.



Compact and contiguous, as much as possible




Other local considerations
