Anyone may submit public comments to the Sacramento County Board of Education on any item that is within the Board's subject matter jurisdiction. However, the Board may not take action on any item not on the agenda except as authorized by Government Code section 54954.2. Anyone may provide public comments to the Board in support of or in opposition to any item being presented to the Board for consideration.
